IOCL : Gujarat Refinery organises Study Visit for Students in December 2021 (Phase-2) as part of 'Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav'-26.11.2021

As part of the list of activities for celebrating 75 Years of Independence under the campaign - 'Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav' as per the directive of MoPNG and as advised by RHq/CO vide e-mail dated 26.08.2021, IOCL Gujarat Refinery had conducted Study Visit to Gujarat Refinery in December 2021 (Phase-2) for the benefit of Students besides a knowledge sharing session with IOCL Engineers. Accordingly, four students group of approx. 100-110 students per group totalling about 410 engineering students from (1) Department of Chemical Engineering, Petroleum Engineering and Mechanical Engineering of Parul Institute of Technology, Parul University Vadodara; and (2) Engineering Students from the Department of Chemical Engineering of GSFC University, Vadodara; have undertaken the study visit to Gujarat Refinery during the period from 14-17 December 2021.

The programme begins with a Safety briefing followed by field visit to the Process Units in Refinery. Later a technical presentation on the overview of Gujarat Refinery, screening of a Corporate Film, knowledge sharing / interactive session with Technial/Production faculty was organised in the programme for the benefit of the students and faculty members.

On this occasion, as a part of awareness generation activities, a brief about IndianOil's Brand Mascot 'Rhino' was shared with the students and faculty members in the training sessions and Caps printed with IndianOil Logo & Rhino Logo were distributed to students. All the study visit activities were organised ensuring adherence to the Covid protocols and hand sanitizer bottles were given to each student. The students and faculty members have been provided with lunch arrangement and transport to & from the respective institutes for facilitating their visit to the Refinery.

It is to be noted that as per the directive of MoPNG and as advised by RHq-CC vide e-mail dated 26.11.2021 for conduct of study visit of students in groups to Refinery, IOCL Gujarat Refinery had organised Study Visit in September 2021 (Phase-1) for about 600 students with few faculty members drawn from - (1) Industrial Technical Institute (ITI), Dasrath, Vadodara; (2) Graduate Engineering students from Chemical, Mechanical, Electrical & Civil Engineering departments of The Maharaja Sayajirao University of Baroda, Vadodara; and (3) Diploma Engineering Students from Chemical, Mechanical, Electrical, Civil & IT Engineering departments from the Polytechnic, The Maharaja Sayajirao University of Baroda, Vadodara; during the period from 21-25 & 29-30 September 2021 in seven groups of approx. 80-90 students per group totalling about 600 students.
