## **OIL organized study visits of students to its secondary tank farm in Madhuban on 24.12.2022**

Oil India Limited (OIL), India's second-largest National Exploration and production company, organized study visits for students of OIL Higher Secondary School, Duliagan to its secondary tank farm, Madhuban, Assam, which was inaugurated by the Shri Narendra Modi, Hon'ble Prime Minister, on 22<sup>nd</sup> February 2021. The visit was organized as a part of ongoing celebrations under Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav.

The students were given a tour of the plant and were briefed about the primary objective of the STF plant, which is to dehydrate the crude oil and reduce the Base Sediment and Water content. Installation engineers explained to students the process through which the formation water is removed from crude oil and is treated in Effluent Treatment Plant (ETP) to make it suitable for disposing into water disposal wells and water injection wells. OIL's STF is an integrated plant where most of the utility requirements are fulfilled in-house, like power generation, water extraction, and treatment, steam generation, etc.
