Madam,

I am directed to refer to Government of Rajasthan (Food & Civil supplies Department) letter No.एफ 65(2) खा.वि/ एलपीजी/ PMUY/केरो.प्रो. रा./2016 dated 8<sup>th</sup> January, 2019 on the subject cited above and to say that quota lapsed by the State Govt. (8196 KL in 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter 2018-19 and 11256 KL in 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter 2018-19) cannot be considered as voluntary surrender. However, quota surrendered in 4<sup>th</sup> quarter(2018-19) i.e. 10,000 KL has been considered and accordingly, the allocation of the PDS Kerosene to the State of Rajasthan has been revised to 20000 KL from 30000 KL for the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter of 2018-19 (January- March). The overall allocation for the 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter shall not exceed 20000 KL.

2. It is further mentioned that the entire allocation has to be uplifted within the quarter itself.
