I am directed to allocate PDS SKO Quota for the 1<sup>st</sup> Quarter 2018-19 to the States/UTs as per the annexure. For the UT of Lakshadweep, full year's allocation of 768 KL (i.e. for 2018-19) has been made in 1<sup>st</sup> Quarter of 2018-19 (April-June, 2018).

- 2. States/UTs are requested to ensure lifting of the entire allocation within the Quarter itself. No carry forward of unlifted quantity, if any, to subsequent Quarter would be allowed, except in case of exigencies such as natural calamities.
- 3. State Governments/UT Administrations are to ensure that availability of subsidized Kerosene is for distribution under Public Distribution System to the targeted beneficiaries, only for the purposes of cooking and illumination. State Governments/UT Administrations are also to ensure that allocated Kerosene is not diverted for adulteration of petrol/diesel or for any other use.
