Subject: **Allocation of Kerosene for distribution under the Public Distribution System (PDS) for the 2<sup>nd</sup> Quarter of 2014-15 (July to September, 2014).**

Sir,

In continuation of this Ministry's letter of even number dated 21<sup>st</sup> March, 2014 and 21<sup>st</sup> April, 2014, I am directed to release allocation of PDS SKO for the 2<sup>nd</sup> Quarter of 2014-15 (July to September, 2014) on the same scale as 2013-14 to all States/UTs as per the Annexure. The total allocation of undivided Andhra Pradesh has been divided in the ratio of 58.40 : 41.60 i.e. for the Andhra Pradesh and Telangana respectively.


2. States/UTs are requested to ensure lifting of the entire allocation within the month itself as per the upliftment schedule communicated earlier. No carry forward of unlifted quantity, if any, to subsequent month(s) would be allowed, except in case of exigencies such as natural calamities.

3. State Governments/UT Administrations are to ensure that availability of subsidized Kerosene is for distribution under Public Distribution System to the targeted beneficiaries; only for the purposes of cooking and illumination. They are also to ensure that Kerosene is not diverted for adulteration of petrol/diesel or for any other use.

4. While releasing Quarterly PDS SKO allocations to the States/UTs, this Ministry has been requesting States/UTs to furnish progress report on weeding out of multiple/ghost/bogus LPG connections. The requisite report has not yet been received in respect of most of the States/UTs. The same may please be furnished to this Ministry urgently, if not furnished so far.

# Allocation for J&K State (other than Laddakh region) is given in two blocks i.e. summer (April – September) @ 40% of annual allocation and winter (October – March) @ 60% of annual allocation. This allocation is for other than Laddakh region of J&K State. For Laddakh region State Government of J&K is allowed to uplift the entire year's allocation i.e. 4626 KL (3600 MTs) of SKO during any time of 2014-15.

\$ Allocation for Lakshadweep for 1008 KL for full financial year i.e. for 2014-15 has already been made.

\*\* Allocation of undivided Andhra Pradesh has been divided in the ratio of 58.40 : 41.60 i.e. for the Andhra Pradesh and Telangana respectively.

@ 2<sup>nd</sup> Quarter actual allocation for the State of Chhattisgarh for the year 2013-14 was 45024 KL. However, allocation of 44214 KL was made in 2<sup>nd</sup> Quarter 2013-14 to Chhattisgarh after reducing advance release of 810 KL made in May, 2013.
