Subject: <u>Pradhan Mantri Ujjwala Yojana – Revised Scheme Guidelines</u>

Sir,

I am directed to say that Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs (CCEA) has approved the proposal of the Ministry to extend the benefit of PMUY to such poor households which are not covered either in the SECC list or in the expanded categories within the provision of Rs. 12800 crore for providing 8 crore LPG connections to BPL families upto the FY 2019-20.

- 2. In view of the above decision, clause 5 of the Revised Guidelines conveyed vide Ministry's letter No. P-17018/1/2016-LPG (Vol.2) dated 12.3.2018 stands modified in respect of identification of beneficiaries belonging to poor families in addition to the existing categories, with immediate effect, as under:
  - i) Connection will be issued in the name of adult woman of the identified poor family, subject to the condition that no other connection exists in the name of prospective beneficiary or other family members.
  - ii) Name of beneficiary should exist in ration card or similar document (issued by State Govt/ District Administration for a household) of the identified household.
  - iii) Submission of Aadhaar number of all the major family members mentioned in Ration card, for the purpose of de-duplication.
  - iv) 14 point declaration from beneficiary in support of BPL nature of the household.
