Minutes of the Monthly Review Meeting on Production & Performance held  
September 20, 2016 under the Chairmanship of Secretary (PNG)

A meeting was held under the Chairmanship of Secretary (PNG) on September 20, 2016 at 10.30 AM with downstream oil & gas CPSEs and at 11.30 AM with upstream oil & gas CPSEs. Action Taken Report (ATR) on decisions taken in the meeting held on August 9, 2016 was discussed and performance during August'16 on production of crude oil, natural gas, crude throughput, Plan & Non-Plan CAPEX, projects, Waste-to-Fuel programme and policy on recruitment of Persons with Disabilities (PWDs) and Visually Handicapped (VH) were reviewed in-depth. The list of participants is at Annexure.

**Downstream**

2. While reviewing the status of PMUY, it was noted that the implementation of the scheme has commenced in 488 districts of 33 states/UTs and about 61 lakh connections (e-SVs) were issued as on September 19, 2016. OMCs have deployed 674 District Nodal officers (DNOs) for this scheme including 343 from IOCL, 171 of BPCL and 160 DNOs from HPCL. It was observed that women DNOs deployed by BPCL and HPCL were only 6 and 5 respectively, which were much less as compared to 41 women DNOs deployed by IOCL. It was suggested that all OMCs especially BPCL & HPCL should encourage women officers and give them preference in shouldering this responsibility. OMCs were advised to also monitor the status of LPG connections being issued other than PMUY scheme and submit state-wise details of such connections issued during the preceding months.

(Action: OMCs)

3. Status of expansion of LPG distributorship network was reviewed in-depth. OMCs informed that process for selection of LPG distributorships that were earlier kept in abeyance for all OMCs were in progress and at various stages of implementation. IOCL informed that they had issued LOI for 351 out of 1229 LPG distributorships, BPCL had issued 187 LOIs out of 1277 LPG distributorships and HPCL had issued 213 LOIs out of 674 LPG distributorships. With regard to 10,000 new LPG distributorships, slippage was observed for around 2500 locations that were planned to be published during 1<sup>st</sup> week of Sept'16. OMCs informed that feasibility studies for 2694 locations in 6 States/UTs had been completed for which advertisements would be published in due course after consultation of stakeholders. JS (M) informed that advertisement in 2 states viz., UP and Odisha were expected to be published by end Sept'16. Secretary (PNG) advised JS (M) to review the possibility of holding of computerized draws in semi-urban and rural areas as was being done in urban areas. He also advised OMCs to make all out efforts to expedite the process so that requisite numbers of LPG distributorships are commissioned as per set timelines.

4. While reviewing DBTK scheme, it was observed that no substantial progress made was by the respective states in implementation of the scheme. Senior Adviser (PNG) mentioned that launch of this programme was required to be expedited in 3 states viz. Gujarat, MP and Chhattisgarh in view of the timeline of Sept'16, set in the
