Sub : Authorization to ONGC, GAIL and Reliance Industries Limited (RIL) for marketing of LPG.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to this Ministry's letter of even number dated 2nd & 3rd February 2005 on the above subject and to say that matter has been re-examined and the aforesaid orders are modified to the following extent:-

- (i) The authorization for marketing of LPG directly by ONGC, GAIL and RIL is allowed with immediate effect.
- (ii) Sale of LPG in the Urban & Rural markets would be in the 75 : 25 ratio.
- (iii) Sale of LPG in domestic and non-domestic (bulk or packed segment) would be in the 80 : 20 ratio.
- (iv) The above ratio of sale of LPG in Urban-Rural and domestic / non-domestic segments may be reviewed by the Government from time to time and the authorized companies would be bound by Government directions in this regard.

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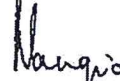
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(v) Monthly statistics of production & total sales in urban / rural areas, domestic & non-domestic segments shall be submitted by the new entrants to Director, PPAC by the 10th of every following month.

2. The Government reserves the right to cancel the authorization to market LPG to any company in case any of the conditions of the authorization are not complied with.
