I am directed to refer to Ministry of Petroleum and Natural Gas letter No.P-19011/5/2005-IOC dated 16.10.2008 on the above subject and to say that the provisions of the existing guidelines have been amended to the following extent with the approval of competent authority :-

"The Sole Proprietor, above 70 years of age can be allowed to resign from dealership (after serving the dealership for minimum 10 years), provided the transfer of share is proposed in favour of one of his heirs."
